

Consent for Online Account Opening, Electronic Disclosures, eStatements, SMS/Text, and eNotices

To apply online, you must consent to electronic delivery of new account disclosures, monthly account statements and account notices. You will need Adobe Acrobat or other software to open and view PDF documents. You understand you are responsible to alert Starion Bank of changes to your contact information, such as email address. Your consent applies to account opening disclosures, monthly statements and notices from Starion Bank, unless you contact Starion Bank to do otherwise or withdraw your consent.

Consent to Receive Phone Text messages: By sending Starion Bank a text message, opening an account online or applying for a consumer loan, you consent to receive transactional SMS / text messages from Starion Bank at the number provided. Consent is not a condition of purchase. Msg & data rates may apply. Msg frequency varies. Unsubscribe at any time by replying STOP or contact us to unsubscribe.

You always have the right to receive your account opening disclosures, monthly statements and notices in paper format. If you would like a paper copy of your account opening disclosures or copies of a previously electronically provided monthly statement or notice, please contact Customer Service at 888-258-6050. A monthly fee of \$3.00 will apply to receive paper monthly statements on your deposit account.

During the application process, you will be required to Accept a packet containing a Deposit Account Agreement (not applicable for loan applications), Privacy Policy and other important information regarding your account. By clicking Accept you confirm that you are able and agree to the Consent for Online Account Opening, Electronic Disclosures, eStatements and eNotices Agreement. To view your eStatements and eNotices from Starion Bank, you will need to log in to Online Banking.
